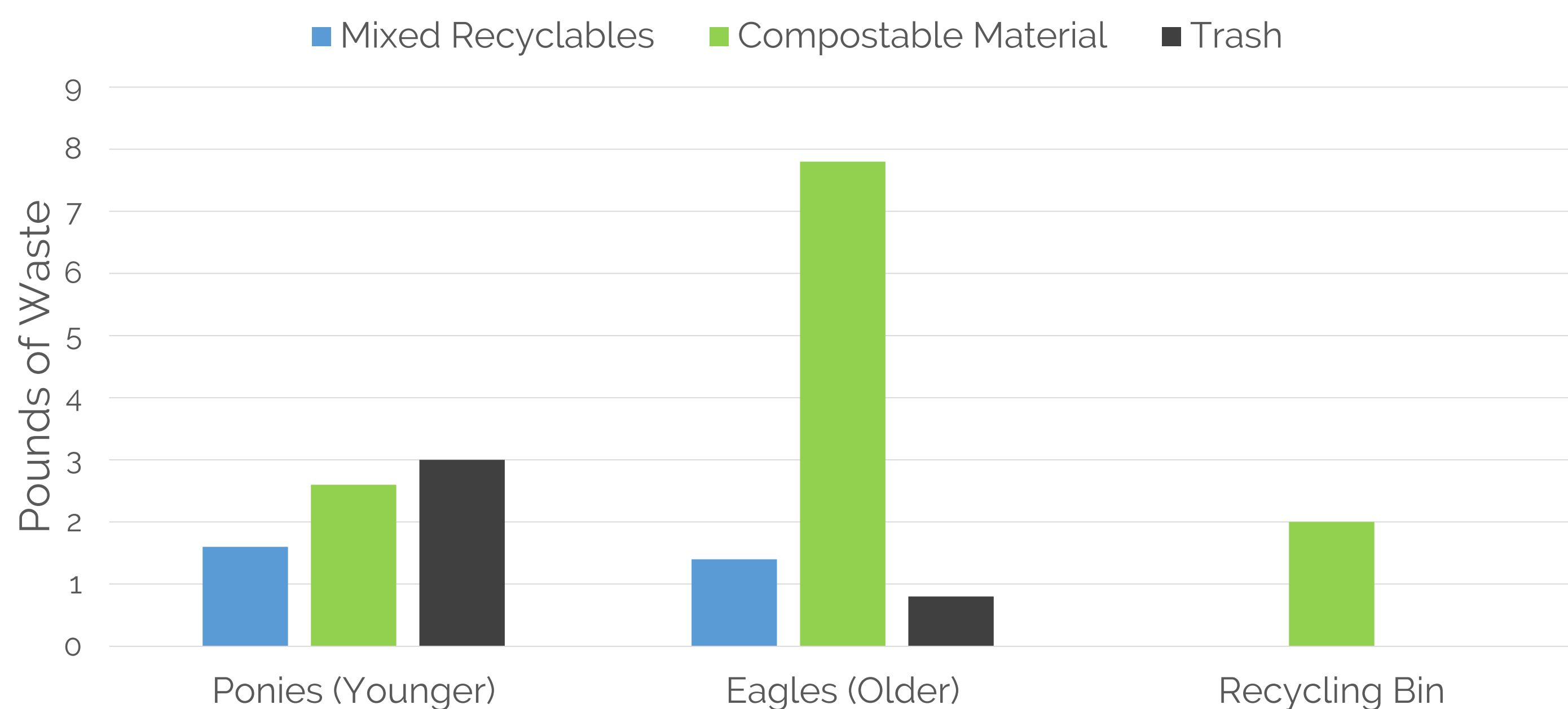

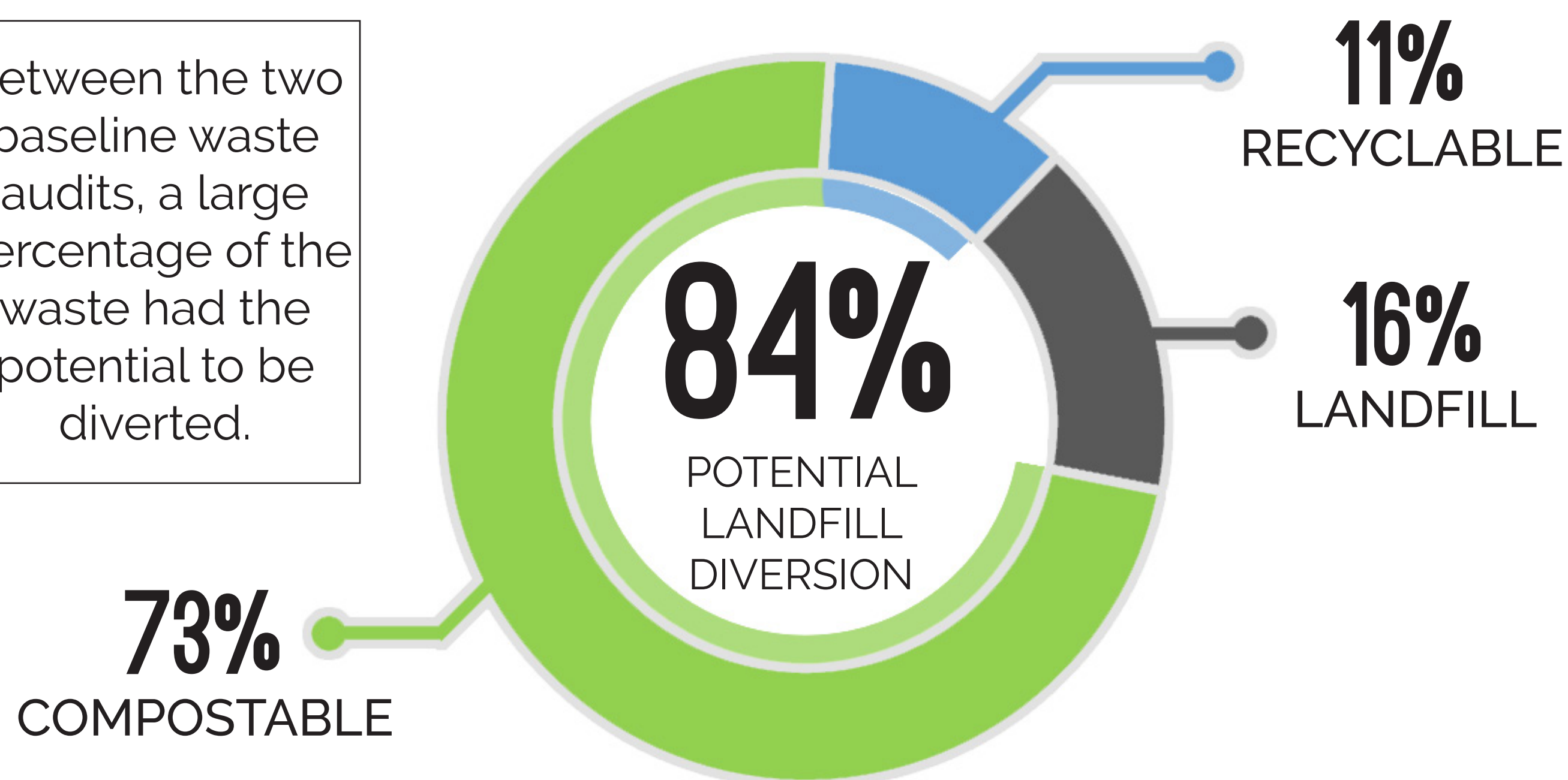


RESULTS

Between the two baseline waste audits, a large percentage of the waste had the potential to be diverted.



METHODOLOGY

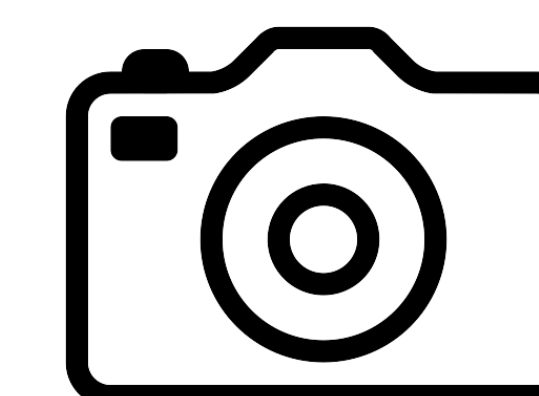


In order to gain an understanding of Krieger's waste, we examined waste disposal practices at the center and waste management processes at UCLA in general.

Two waste audits were carried out to understand the composition of Krieger's waste. The waste from the Ponies and Eagles (toddler and preschool) classrooms was sorted into **compost**, **recycling**, and **trash**.



Walkthroughs of the center were conducted in order to catalogue all the bins in the center. There were 9 classrooms between the infants, toddlers, preschoolers.



We strategized how to arrange the bins to maximize waste diversion. Appropriate signage was created to encourage proper waste sorting.
