SIGNIFICANT HEALTH FINDINGS

Wilmington is disproportionately affected by these health symptoms and conditions as compared to other sites.

3.5x greater risk of dizziness



3.3x greater risk of Throat Infections



3.5x greater risk of Nausea/Vomiting



5x greater risk of Coronary Heart Disease



10x greater risk of Chest Pain/Tightness



1.6x greater risk of Disease

Cómo Puede Involucrarse



This graphic depicts the results of responses from 150 residents surveyed within 0.25 miles of an active oil well (except Pacoima which was used as a control site) in Wilmington, W. Pico, and Pacoima, respectively. The survey consisted of 19 questions and was completely voluntary. Residents were asked to respond to questions about their neighborhood and personal information was collected for demographic and health analysis. No personally identifiable information was collected or reported. This research was conducted by Bruins for Environmental Justice and sponsored by the University of California, Los Angeles.
