QUICK FACTS

- Climate change is accelerating.
- The record high temperatures have increased and are seen during extreme weather events.
- Collective action can have the greatest impact on mitigating climate change.
- People living in vulnerable areas, coastal communities, and some ocean islands may need to relocate.
- Continued warming of the planet could affect the geographic range of temperature-limited diseases.
- Heat waves could cause more deaths to very young, very old, and those without access to air conditioning.
