QUICK FACTS

- Coastal wetlands help protect coastlines by acting as a permeable barrier that slows waves and reduces flooding.
- The largest human-caused hypoxic zone currently affecting the United States, and the second largest worldwide, occurs in the northern Gulf of Mexico.
- The BP oil spill had an impact on Louisiana wetlands, barrier islands and the rate of coastal erosion.
- The coastal area is home to nearly one-third of Louisiana's population.
